

RULES	World Aquatics competition regulations (<u>link</u>) and Sweden Aquatics competition adjustments (<u>link</u>) will govern the championships.	
PROTESTS	Protests shall comply with Swedish Swimming Federation Rules (protests). The protest fee is SEK 600 and shall be paid in cash or Swish.	
START LISTS	Link to start lists are found here . The start order for all events are done automatically through the scoring program.	
DRAW OF FIGURES	The draw of figures is done Wednesday 8 th of May 2024 at 09:00 AM by the Referee and Assistant Referee. The drawn figures will be posted on Sweden Aquatics website, <u>here</u> .	
RESERVES	Changes of reserves shall be submitted to the Referee at least two hours prior to the start of the session.	
SHOWING OF SCORES	Scoring during Youth Figures: Scores are shown by judges on score cards after each competitor. Scoring during music routines: Judges scores are shown on the score board after the routine has finished. The preliminary total score is presented on the score board after the next routine if time allows.	
RESULTS	Link to results and detailed results will be posted here after each session and award ceremony is completed.	
CEREMONIES	Please wear club or national team uniforms and shoes/slippers during the opening ceremony and award ceremonies. Line-up for opening ceremony in the corridor outside locker rooms, with clubs and national teams in alphabetical order.	
COMPETITION AND PRACTISE POOLS AND RULES	Competition pool (pool A): 25m x 25m (3 m deep) Warm-up pool 1 (pool B): 25m x 15m (3 m deep) Warm-up/Cool-down pool 2 – lane 4 (pool C): 50m x 2m (1,9m deep)	
	 No tapping is allowed at any time. Pool A + B: Practise only according to schedule or after announcement by Referee. Pool B: The lane closest to the cafeteria may be used for warm-up for competitors waiting for their start-number. No other use of Pool B is allowed while competition is going on in pool A. Non-compliance may result in disqualification. See Annex for pool set up during competition. Pool C is the 50-meter pool, located to the left when you walk out from locker rooms. See competition schedule for which hours pool C is booked and can be used. 	
LOCKERS	Locker rooms 6-9 shall be used. Padlocks are needed for the lockers. Please make sure you put clothes, shoes and other belongings in the lockers as there have been thefts. Larger items can be stored by the competition pool, please contact the event manager.	
SPECTATORS	There is no entry fee to the spectator area during the competition. Spectators are referred to the stands closest to the gym to get the best view of the competition.

SUBMISSION OF MUSIC

Music Files shall be submitted electronically via Google Drive. A Google Drive folder for each club or national team will be sent out by the event manager. Each file shall be clearly labelled according to the following examples:

All coaches are highly recommended to bring a copy of the music as backup.

Only file formats of good quality and mp3/wav files are permitted.

SUBMISSION OF COACH CARDS

Coach Cards shall be submitted electronically via Google Drive. A Google Drive folder for each club or national team will be sent out by the event manager. Each Coach Card shall be clearly labelled according to the following examples:

Only the current Coach Card version found here will be permitted for use during the championships.



REFUSAL OF ENTRIES

Please note that entries, Coach Cards, and Music Files must be presented in the format required and before the deadline. Entries that do not respect these deadlines and formats may be rejected. These regulations are specified to respect the organising clubs and officials to carry out their preparations in time.

LUNCH

Clubs/national teams who have ordered lunch will receive food tickets, to be presented when collecting the meals. Judges and technical controllers will receive food tickets at the Officials' Meetings. All meals are served at Eriksdalsbadet restaurant. Food for accompanying families and other audience is available in the restaurant at the lower entrance.

TRANSPORTATION

The most convenient way to Eriksdalsbadet is to take the subway to "Skanstull" (red line). After arrival, pass Clarion Hotel and walk down to the main entrance of Eriksdalsbadet.

Note that parking at Eriksdalsbadet is not free and may be restricted to maximum time limit.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Basic medical services/equipment will be available during the competition at the venue in the doctors' room by the competition pool.

HANDLING OF GELATINE

It is important that we do not leave gelatine residue or hairpins in wash basins or any other surface in the toilets, showers, changing rooms or on the poolside. Please make sure that you clean any gelatine residue after applying or removing gelatine (on both floor and other surfaces). Please use the intended baskets. Team Managers are responsible for checking that their club/national team cleans up properly.



Start point for music routines at the window wall, stairs for leaving the pool at the left corner closest to the locker room 3.

Please note that the start area is at the same level as the pool surface.
